- 6. Illustrate the harmonious relations shared by diverse communities in his childhood as recalled by Mohammed Aamir Khan in his memoir *Framed as a Terrorist*.
- 7. Examine Arundhati Roy's attempt to settle down to a comparatively sedate life after the euphoric phase of her life on being awarded The Booker Prize.
- 8. Justify the use of 'what' rather than 'who 'that is used by Michel Foucault in the title of his essay What is an Author?
- 9. Who is referred to as the lord of the flies by Golding and give reasons for the same.
- 10. Define Choreopoems and discuss their unique contribution as distinct from poems and drama.
